

NOTIFICATION FOR THE CONDUCT OF ONLINE NURSING EXAMINATION

Instructions regarding conduct of Nursing Online Examination

- 1. Application Forms are available purely on online mode.**
- 2. Candidates are requested to enter the college choices while filling up the form for the purpose of counseling.**
- 3. E-Admit card will be issued only after the successful submission of Application Form.**
- 4. E-Admit card will be issued 10.09.2019 onwards.**
- 5. The Candidates must remember their application Identity No. along with Date of Birth mentioned at the time of filling up the examination form for taking the print – out of admit card.**
- 6. Candidates appearing in the computer-based test.**
- 7. The candidate should bring only E-Admit Card, valid Photo Identification Card, 02 recent color passport size photograph(s) and Blue ball Point Pen to Test Centre.**
- 8. No candidate will be allowed to enter at the Test Centre without valid E-Admit Card and Photo Identification Card as mentioned above.**
- 9. Candidates are strictly advised not to bring any electronic devices, viz., mobile/cellular/smart phones, electronic gadgets, pen drives, hard disks, earphones or microphones, electronic watches with computing facilities, electronic or non electronic communication devices, hand bags, purse, calculator, log tables, pagers, digital diaries, books, note books etc. which are strictly prohibited in test centers. If any candidate found in possession of any of these devices/documents, his/her candidature is liable to be disqualified. Candidates are also advised not to bring any valuable costly items to the test centers as arrangement for safe keeping will not be provided and test centre will not be responsible for safe custody, loss or theft.**
- 10. Online entrance examination will be conducted on 14th, 15th September – 2019 in slot format.**
- 11. Candidates must report to their allotted Test Centre at least 30 Minutes before the commencement of test for the completion of attendance formalities.**
- 12. The candidate cannot leave the examination hall till the examination is over.**
- 13. No request for change in test date/session/centre/venue will be considered under any Circumstances.**

14. Entrance paper for UG aspirants will comprise of 50 marks in total and the question paper will be prepared in the following pattern –

- a) English - 10 Marks**
- b) Physics (Up to secondary level) - 10 Marks**
- c) Chemistry (Up to secondary level) - 10 Marks**
- d) Biology (Up to secondary level) - 10 Marks**
- e) General Aptitude - 10 Marks**

15. Entrance paper for PG aspirants (i.e - M.Sc Nursing, NPCC, Post Basic B.Sc Nursing) will comprise of 50 marks in total and the question paper will be prepared in the following pattern –

- a) English - 10 Marks**
- b) Physics - 10 Marks**
- c) Nursing Education - 10 Marks**
- d) Biology - 10 Marks**
- e) General Aptitude - 10 Marks**

16. There is no provision of negative marking in the entrance examination.

17. The question paper designed is based on multiple choices. There will more than 2 choices and only one choice will be correct out of many.

18. Mock/ Sample session will be introduced in the website in order to make the applicant understand to how make his/ her choices.

19. Counseling policies and procedures will be notified in the website after the declaration of result.

20. The Candidate can be debarred from the entrance examination/final admission on any of the following grounds:

- a) No match of basic applicable criteria as mentioned by the regulatory bodies.**
- b) In correct / mismatch of identity as mentioned in online form.**
- c) Mismatch the original/ photo copies of educational documents of the candidate.**
- d) In case the basic educational not match with the Government Approved Boards of Secondary/ Sr. Secondary.**
- e) False statement produced at the time of filling up the examination form.**
